

Penny A Prayer for Priests

Directions for Bottle Priests! (to collect those pennies)

32 oz Bottle

19 1/2" Long X 12" Black material
(stiff cotton/polyester blend works best)
White Paint for the Bottle cap
Paint Brush
Tacky Glue
12 Pom poms -
Black (approximately 1/4" round) for buttons



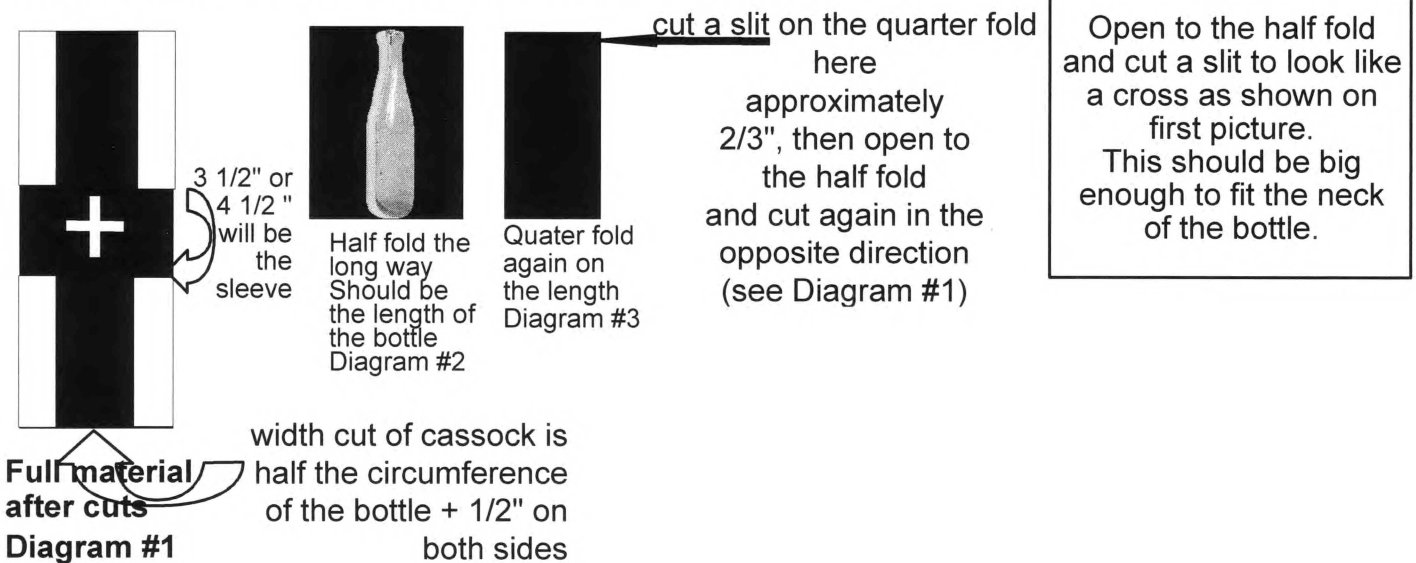
8 oz Bottle

12" Long X 8" Wide - Black material
(stiff cotton/polyester blend works best)
Tacky Glue
Cap from the Bottle
White Paint/Brush
9 Pom poms -
Black (approximately 1/4" round) for buttons



Directions:

After cutting the material, fold in half and then half again.



The cross section slit is shown bigger than it should be for visual reference.

Do not cut the sleeve area until after you cut the center slit.

Directions

Paint the bottle cap white - this is the Priests collar! (may require more than 1 coat)
Collar Area: Cut the slit (see Diagrams #1, #2, #3) in the center of the material, place the material over the neck of the bottle.

Main Cassock: Measure the material as it fits around the bottle* and cut the material as shown in Diagram # 1 (Full).

*Measure the half circumference of the bottle leaving an overlap of about 1/2" on both sides of the material (this is how wide the material will be for the main part of the cassock - and cut (see Diagram # 1)

Sleeves should be at least 4 1/2" wide for the large bottle and 3 1/2" wide for the small bottle. (see Diagram # 1)

Cassock: Glue the material to the bottle - glue the overlapping material under the sleeve area. Do not include the material that will be used for the sleeve.

Trim material (if necessary) at the bottom of the Cassock which is too long for the bottle to stand.
Sleeve: Fold the material (3 1/2" or 4 1/2") over the 2 opposite sides to look like sleeves. (tuck/roll the material to form rounded sleeves and glue the sleeve together and then to the Cassock area).
As the glue dries add the buttons down the front of the Cassock.

Where the slits were cut at the neck, the material will stand up around the neck area. This can be left, tucked in or cut off.
